**PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW CAREFULLY! STUDENTS WILL BE HELD STRICTLY ACCOUNTABLE IN ABIDING BY ALL THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO STUDENT PARKING ON THE NHS CAMPUS.**

To apply for a student parking permit, NHS seniors (class of 2018) must provide the following items in person: (1) this form completed in ink **and signed/preapproved on reverse side by an NHS administrator if submitted after August 28, 2017**; (2) a valid Connecticut driver’s license (permits are not accepted); (3) vehicle registration for vehicle(s) to be registered to park on campus and (4) the actual vehicle(s) that will be parked on campus (permit should be affixed to bottom left of interior windshield). Student parking fees are payable to “Newtown High School” check only.

 \$100 Registration (applications submitted after August 28, 2017)

**NHS Campus Parking Rules and Regulations for Students**

Campus parking for students is a privilege. It is important for students and parents to understand that they will be held responsible to abide by all campus rules and regulations. Violation of any of the following may result in disciplinary consequences, including but not limited to monetary fines, suspension or revocation of your parking permit without refund, and/or towing of your vehicle at owner’s (your) expense.

- Under no circumstances shall a student sell, transfer, or convey use of his/her parking permit and/or designated parking space to another student or individual, including family members.
- A student’s designated parking space is strictly for that student’s use for the entire school year including exams.
- Students parking on campus do so at their own risk. The Newtown Public Schools is not responsible for damage, vandalism and/or mischief that may occur to a student’s vehicle while parked on campus.
- Students shall park only in their assigned parking space. Should a student arrive on campus and find a vehicle parked in their assigned space, the student shall park his/her vehicle on the pavement adjacent to the stadium concession stand and immediately summon security personnel.
- Under no circumstances shall a student park in a faculty parking space, visitor parking space, in another student parking space, fire lane, grass area or sidewalk.
- Students are generally not permitted to exit the school building to go to their vehicle during the school day.
- The campus speed limit is 15 mph. Students shall obey the campus speed limit, shall yield to school buses and pedestrians and shall always abide by the directions of security personnel, police, administration, traffic control officers and signage and/or cone patterns.
- Students assigned to park in the Oakview Drive lot behind the baseball field shall remove their vehicle no later than 2:15 pm. Vehicles left behind after this time may be locked in or towed at owner’s expense.
- Any student with an ongoing record of behavioral referrals, including but not limited to attendance, class cuts, tardiness, leaving campus without authorization, or poor grades is subject to suspension or revocation of his/her campus parking permit without refund.
- NHS Administration reserves the right to suspend, modify and/or cancel student parking, including moving or changing a student’s assigned parking space, due to educational issues, safety concerns, disciplinary issues, emergency situations and/or inclement weather (i.e. snow removal).

**NHS Student Parking  
2017-2018 School Year**

NHS administration is accepting class of 2018 senior parking applications beginning July 10, 2017 from 8AM to 1PM, Monday through Thursday. The fee for student parking on the Newtown High School campus for the upcoming 2017-18 school year will be \$100. However, NHS seniors (class of 2018) who have been issued a valid Connecticut driver's license on or before August 28, 2017 and who register for campus parking on or before that date will be charged a discounted rate of \$85.00.

NHS seniors (class of 2018) who were issued a valid Connecticut driver's license prior to August 28, 2017, but did not register for student parking on or before August 28, 2017, will be charged the full \$100 fee when they register for parking after that date. Students that apply for parking during various times during the school year may be subject to a price reduction.

**Frequently Asked Questions**

1. I will be out of town or unavailable to register for parking over the summer. Can my parent or guardian register me for student parking?  
Answer: YES. However your parent/guardian must provide a copy of both sides of your CT driver's license along with the completed form (signed by you and your parent/guardian), registration(s) and vehicles(s).
  
2. What if I'm a senior, but I don't expect to obtain my driver's license until October or November?  
Answer: You may put your name on the student parking "waiting list" that will be maintained by NHS administration.
  
3. I'm a junior (class of 2018) at NHS; can I register for student parking?  
Answer: NO. NHS administration will determine procedures for junior parking at a later date (anticipated late September) with instructions subsequently provided to juniors regarding said plans and procedures.
